Support should not extend to other major towns or cities, e.g. Basingstoke, Salisbury or, Southampton, which benefit from your support, even where these fall within the 20-mile radius.

The following guidelines may help you prepare your application.

Community groups or charities we are able to support

The Helping Hands Grants help community groups and charities that:

- Operate within and support the local area, defined as being within a 20-mile radius of the Andover office (SP10 1DE)
- Are a local branch of national organisation/charity targeting support for the local area and local people
- Help support or promote health and wellbeing, including the environment
- Support those less able to support themselves
- Whose wellbeing is dependent upon the support of animals, e.g. Guide dogs etc.

The Community Impact Working Group's decision is final. All decisions will be communicated to the charity/community group by the ESG Manager or Administrator.

Charities or initiatives we are generally unable to help

Applications generally will not be considered for:

- Support outside the local area, or groups where the funds help supply support on a national or international basis
- General appeals for non-targeted funding and disaster appeals e.g. DEC
- Research purposes or projects
- Promoting religious or political causes
- Organisations solely supporting animals e.g. rescue centres
- Heritage, building restoration projects or more general building works including maintenance
- Funding that will solely be used for marketing or promotional activity i.e. literature, leaflets, diaries, flyers, posters etc.
- Money to pay for an individual's salary on an ongoing basis

Exceptions to the above exclusions will be considered on their merits, on a case-by-case basis.
